South Asian University (SAU) was established in 2010 with an objective of equipping the young minds of the South Asian region with world-class cutting-edge knowledge and nurturing regional consciousness. It is a joint initiative of the eight member states of South Asian Association for Regional Cooperation (SAARC) viz. Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Bhutan, India, Maldives, Nepal, Pakistan and Sri Lanka.

Located in Maidan Garhi, South Delhi, SAU offers Bachelor's, Master's and Research programmes. SAU offers a unique blend of multicultural and cosmopolitan experience drawing students and faculty from across South Asia. In the near future, the university will expand to accommodate about 13 Faculties with more than 5000 students.

Admissions

Total Intake

The total number of seats for BTech (CSE) and BTech Dual Degree (CSE) Programmes are given below:

Btech Computer Science & Engineering - 90 (India: 40 through JEE Main score & 5 through entrance; & Other SAARC Countries: 45 through entrance)

Dual Degree BTech-MTech Computer Science & Engineering - 30 (India: 12 through JEE Main & 3 through entrance; & Other SAARC Countries: 15 through entrance)

MSc Computer Science - 20 | MTech Computer Science - 30 | Integrated MSc + MTech - 20 | All other Master's Programmes - 80/90

The intake details for PhD Programmes for both Direct and Entrance Test Modes are: Biotechnology 16 (Direct 10 + Entrance 6), Computer Science 12 (D 6 + E6), Economics 7 (D 1 + E 6), International Relations 12 (D 6 + E 6), Legal Studies 6 (D 3 + E 3), Mathematics 11 (D 5 + E 6), Sociology 11 (D 6 + E 5)

*Note: The allocation of seats under each category is flexible. If no applicant meets required selection criteria, then the applicant from another category will be offered the seat.

Country-Wise Student Quota

India - 50%

Afghanistan, Bhutan, Maldives, Nepal and Sri Lanka – 4% Each

Pakistan and Bangladesh – 10% Each

Students from outside the SAARC region - 10%

Note:

- Merit lists will be prepared country-wise and the competition will only be amongst candidates within each country.
- If the seats allocated to a particular country are not filled, they will be allocated to students from other countries, as per SAU rules.

Application Fee, Date and Test Centres

The fee for appearing in the Entrance Test is US\$10 or INR 830. Applications for admission will be accepted only online and payment must also be made through online mode. A computer-based Entrance Test will be conducted simultaneously throughout the SAARC region on 20 and 21 April 2024 as per the schedule.

Dedicated test centres throughout SAARC countries are chosen for the entrance test. Check the university website for the test centres.

Last date of online application is 31 March 2024.
